What is narcissism?

Narcissism is a personality disorder that is diagnosed by observing a pattern of long term behavior that is against the norms of society and culture. It is characterized by unhealthy and exaggerated feelings of self-absorption coupled with a lack of understanding of other people's needs, desires and feelings.

Narcissism is difficult to diagnose and difficult to treat and most attention to this disorder is focused on the sufferer of narcissistic tendencies as very little information exists on how to help the victims of NPD abuse.

In today's webisode, I'd like to talk to you about narcissism. What is narcissism exactly and how does it relate to you as it related to people in scripture. I also want to share with you how you can finally discover freedom from narcissistic abuse no matter if you suffer from Post-Traumatic Stress, infantile regression, Stockholm syndrome or any other form of trauma forced upon you by a narcissist.

Narcissism is a coined term that is tossed around on the internet and in social circles. The truth of the matter is; is that we all express narcissistic tendencies now and again and we all at one time can label ourselves as narcissists. Narcissism is healthy, ONLY when it is used to promote you in a way that doesn't hurt people. Narcissistic tendencies are a way of life for most of us and how they become unhealthy is when they inflict physical and emotional injury on someone else. This is when narcissism becomes insidious and dangerous.

By clinical definition, narcissism is a personality disorder. What that means is that within someone's innate character there is discontinuity, and disconformity; an imbalance of what the standards of morality within society are as this imbalance comes with a disregard. The narcissist disregards the rules and boundaries of the norms of society and within personal relationships and family life and this is seen as a non-issue by the narcissist. The narcissist does not realize that they have any flaws in their personality and instead regard society and individuals on the outside as abnormal and flawed even dysfunctional and backwards in logic. A personality disorder such as narcissism is a disorder of an individual's character and character is defined as who someone is through emotional health and well-being.

A narcissist is emotionally unhealthy and unwell. They don't know it and often we don't know that they are because we are too busy trying to pick ourselves back up from an emotional verbal or physical tirade from a narcissistic abuser. We can't see them for who they are initially because as I have said before, we all carry narcissistic tendencies, and all of us know this behavior because we all once lived it; as children.

As infants and children we express our feelings of uncomfortability through various negative outcomes; crying initially and then the behavior progresses as we get older if our cries are unanswered. Hitting, biting, spitting, throwing things, screaming even refusing to do what is expected of us. These things are attention getting measures we do as children to get our way. These are extremely selfish acts and normally we grow out of them but for the adult who stays a narcissists and adopts narcissistic tendencies, they are emotionally stunted and remain infantile expecting their adult peers to tow the line and give into their demands.

Psychologists have concluded that narcissistic personalities are made not born; because negative parental patterns have been directly linked to specific types of narcissism. From overweening and controlling parents to absent and neglectful ones, narcissistic tendencies have a root from within the family home. This root is often traced back to- the mother. While the studies maybe definitive, through this author's own research in studying scripture and human behavior within peer support counseling, the answers are far deeper than what we can imagine.

The root of narcissistic tendencies goes further back in history than what clinicians assume. There is a reason why narcissism is becoming an epidemic today as there is a reason why so many victims are speaking out. Narcissists are not just made, they are born.

“And I will put enmity between you and the woman and between your offspring and hers.”
Genesis 3:15

Scripture shares with us in the garden of Eden a curse between the enemy and his children and the children of God through Eve. The murderous child of Eve named Cain who killed his brother Able is proof of this curse. It’s hard to imagine that brothers would fight to the death over simple matters but these two individuals were not rooted in their brotherhood by spirit or flesh in totality. These two boys were not as close to one another as we may assume. There is a reason why one brother killed the other and that is because one brother held contempt, while the other did not. Cain and Able had things not in common with one another and this is what separated them by blood. Cain was murderous, Abel was not. If Adam and Eve were not murderous than where did this murder come from? Where did Cain get his murderous ambition from?

The enemy had something in common with Cain. Jealousy, conceit, contempt, deception, arrogance, selfishness, abusiveness, and lacking self-control. These are the character flaws that naturally separate one from God. The enemy separated himself from God when he in his heart tried to assume he was as beautiful and as powerful as the Almighty. Cain separated himself from God when he murdered his brother, but unbeknownst to the reader, Cain was already separated from God through his birth.

Who was the serpent?

The bible uses metaphors to help convey contextual meaning. All throughout scripture we can find God comparing people to various types of animals. This does not mean that people are animals certainly not! It does however let us in on a little hidden trait within human nature; our human instincts are animalistic in nature depending on our character flaws that are drawn out of us. The sins we commit expose our instinctual tendencies that reveal our hidden animalistic qualities.

We are encouraged not to throw our pearls before swine. Pigs are garbage eaters, although they are clean, when they are hungry they are gluttonous. People can be gluttonous too, not all people indulge on food, as some people indulge instead on drink, and sex, or other sins that feed their lustful desires.

We are to be wary of wolves in sheep’s clothing. Sheep are natural followers, and people who follow the Good Shepard are those who follow after Jesus who is righteous. The wolves are those individuals who like wolves follow their prey and give chase. Wolves naturally prey upon

the weak or the young and the people who have disguised themselves as trust worthy and friendly are instinctually ready to devour the people that befriend them.

We are encouraged to be as innocent as the dove and as shrewd as the snake. To keep ourselves clean like the dove who is dressed in white feathers. We are to stay away from even the appearance of evil this is how we keep ourselves free from its destructive and corrupting ways. To be as shrewd as a snake means to keep our hearts protected and not give away our emotional power away to just anyone. We are to judge ourselves and others accordingly according to the word of God by observing the fruit that they bare. To be shrewd means to be mindful and intellectually thinking about situations, people and things so that we are not led astray and get hurt. With all the metaphors of scripture comparing people to animals it would be wrong for us to continue to assume that the serpent that tempted Eve as a slithering snake that somehow had the ability to talk.

“How you have fallen from heaven O morning star, son of the dawn! You have been cast down to the earth, you who once laid low the nations.!

You said in your heart, “I will ascend to heaven; I will raise my throne above the stars of God; I will sit enthroned on the mount of assembly, on the utmost heights of the sacred mountain. I will make myself like the Most High. But you are brought down to the grave, to the depths of the pit.” Isaiah 14:12-15

“You were the model of perfection, full of wisdom and perfect in beauty.” Ezekiel 28:12

“Your heart became proud on account of your beauty and you corrupted your wisdom because of your splendor.” Ezekiel 28:15-16

“By your many sins and dishonest trade you have desecrated your sanctuaries.” Ezekiel 28:18

“Cursed are you above all the livestock and all the wild animals! You will crawl on your belly and you will eat dust all the days of your life. And I will put enmity between you and the woman and between your offspring and hers; he will crush your head and you will strike his heel.”

Genesis 3:15

If the serpent WAS a snake, an animal then how would the curse ever be overcome through Jesus our Lord and Savior? Jesus through His death and resurrection brought this curse into effect. Judas was overcome by the enemy and thus betrayed Jesus. If the enemy was a snake, then how would Judas be overcome by the enemy who was present at the garden and whom Jesus authority dismantled through the cross?

The enemy that was given what we assume the name of ‘serpent’ is not used in the original Hebrew language as a noun, but as a verb. The Hebrew language gave meaning to people places and things according to their function and appearance. The function of the enemy in the garden was to deceive, and his appearance wasn’t serpent like in nature according to the animal. His

character was serpent like and that is what scripture calls attention to. This is a running theme throughout scripture and does not change because God's word cannot change. Going back to Ezekiel we are shown just who the serpent really was and what he looked like.

"You were in Eden, the garden of God, every precious stone adorned you." Ezekiel 28:14

"So I drove you in disgrace from the mount of God, and I expelled you. O guardian Cherub." Ezekiel 28:16

Clearly a snake is not a cherub, but we know through other metaphors mentioned in scripture this particular cherub had snake like or serpentine qualities in his character.

Snakes hunt their prey. They first seek out their food source by detecting heat signatures and chemicals in the air. Once the snake locks onto its target, it will not deviate unless its life is threatened or the target is too much for the snake to handle. Snakes hunt live prey and will always go for the head first. They swallow their food whole. Some snakes constrict their prey to death while others offer a venomous bite while constricting their prey. By the time the venom has taken hold, the snake has already devoured its meal whole.

A snake is always on guard when it is out in the open. It will strike even when it is not provoked. It uses its strong muscles to slither around and make a fast getaway. These reptiles are temperamental and extremely instinctual. They don't always slither and hide. Some snakes remain out in the open because they know they are a threat to even the larger animals that have the ability to kill the snake in one fell swoop. The venomous snakes are the boldest of the snakes because they do not have many predators. They put their trust in their venomous bite.

The word 'serpent' in the Hebrew language does mean snake, but in order for it to make sense in contextual meaning it is important to understand that there are other definitions within the Hebrew language that back up the other scriptural references that share with its reader that the serpent in the garden of Eden was a cherub; a spiritual living creature. Strong's dictionary reference #5175 does mean snake, but that is not the only definition the Hebrew word Nachash is attached to. Nachash (Pronounced nah-hash), is also defined as to whisper, an enchanter, learn by experience, incantation, copper; **brass**.

"The center of the fire looked like glowing metal, and in the fire was what looked like four living creatures. In appearance their form was that of a man, but each of them had four faces and four wings. Their legs were straight; their feet were like those of a calf and gleamed like burnished bronze." Ezekiel 1:4-7

The context of scripture backed up with the Hebrew language clears up any and all misunderstandings of what the serpent looked like in the garden. He may have had serpentine qualities but the emphasis should always be on his characteristics that were instinctual and animalistic in nature.

What did the serpent offer Eve?

Many bible scholars and commentary promote that the enemy offered Eve an apple. This has been the subject of much debate and to rid the confusion surrounding this detail we can find the solution written in the meaning of the curses given out by God Himself in the garden. To be sure, nowhere in scripture are we shown that Eve ate an apple. This is a myth promoted from Renaissance paintings. The truth of the matter is; the serpent who is a spiritual creature enticed Eve and that enticement brought on consequences that bore spiritual and physical fruit; namely children.

The tree of knowledge was not a bad tree. It held both spiritual kinds of fruit; both good and bad. The tree was a tree that gave knowledge when one partook in specific kinds of deeds; good or bad. Goodness gives rise to good fruit and bad gives rise to bad fruit. How knowledge comes to us is by using our five senses; sight, sound, taste, smell, or touch. Once can be shown knowledge through example, but to really have a personal knowing about something or someone, one must experience the knowledge for themselves.

Eve was shown knowledge, but she did not gain an understanding of it until she experienced it herself. She acted upon the knowledge shown to her. She was enticed as she desired the fruit of the spirit offered to her. Does it really make sense that Eve was enticed and desired an apple- a piece of fruit which caused God to put a curse on her body through child bearing? Did your parents always dole out punishment that didn't fit your wrong doing? Although their punishment may have seemed unfair, a loving parent never gives to us anything different than what we deserve. The punishment fits the crime or transgression. In Eve's case it would not make sense that she would labor and toil in pain during childbirth just because she ate an apple.

The punishment for partaking in forbidden fruit:

To the enemy: "And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; he will crush your head and you will strike his heel." Genesis 3:15

To Eve: "I will greatly increase your pains in childbearing, with pain you will give birth to children. Your desire will be for your husband, and he will rule over you." Genesis 3:16

To Adam: "Cursed is the ground because of you, through painful toil you will eat of it all the days of your life. It will produce thorns and thistles for you, and you will eat the plants of the field. By the sweat of your brow you will eat your food until you return to the ground." Genesis 3:19

The enemy tried to come in between Adam and Eve and he succeeded, to which God stepped in with specific punishments in the form of curses to help hold us all accountable to be mindful of what exactly happened and what should never happen again.

The enemy enticed Eve before she had a chance to fulfill her role with Adam. God told them to be fruitful and multiply but instead the enemy came and placed a wedge in between them. The curses that God gave to each participant involved family in some way. Adam's curse forced him to work away from the home, away from his wife and children, Eve would suffer during child birth and this at times would threaten her life and the enemy was given the curse of his children and Eve's children born with Adam would always be enemies. With this background history we can now ask the question: How did Cain become a murderer?

Many people assume that Cain was Adam's son. If this was the case, then where did his murderous ambition come from? Adam was not a murderer, and Eve wasn't, so if the children born of these two people did not have murderous ambition in their blood, where did murder come from?

"The good man brings good things out of the good stored up in him, and the evil man brings evil things out of the evil stored up in him." Matthew 12:35

"The weeds are the sons of the evil one and the enemy who sows them is the devil."
Matthew 13:37-38

"You belong to your father, the devil, and you want to carry out your father's desire. He was a murderer from the beginning, not holding to the truth for there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks his native language, for he is a liar and the father of lies." John 8:44

The words of Jesus share with us who Cain really was. He was the product of his father, the enemy who enticed Eve as the cherub was the forbidden fruit that both Adam and Eve were not allowed to even touch.

Because Eve was created from Adam, these two people shared the same genes as they had the same blood type. They also shared the breath of life given to Adam through the breath of God as both Adam and Eve were created in the spiritual image of God; love. Knowing this we can understand that any children Adam and Eve had together would also share with them in this likeness in every way; physically and spiritually. Adam and Eve were not murderers and their children that they would create together would not be murderers either. The murdering father who had a child in his image was the serpent and his son was Cain.

Science can give us some added insight as blood types were only discovered in the 1900's. While performing experiments on blood compatibility between species, it was discovered by accident that each person has their own immune system specific to their blood type. This proved that not all blood is compatible by nature. If blood from one specific blood type mixes with another specific blood type, and these two blood types are incompatible with one another, this kicks in the body's immune system into action to reject the offending blood type from the host body.

Attached to the surface of red blood cells is a protein called the Rh factor. This protein is inherited through the male parent. Just to sideline the topic for a minute, the bible tells us that life is in the blood. The spiritual accentuation of man is contained in the blood. Eve was created from Adam's rib and the rib bone is one of the few bones in the body that contain a spongy material called bone marrow. Bone marrow is where blood for the body is made. The Rh factor attached to Adam's immune system was given to Eve and so it is safe to conclude through the help of scientific discovery that Adam and Eve had the same blood type. Keeping this in mind, science shows us that not everyone has the Rh protein. Individuals who have the Rh factor or protein are said to be Rh positive. Those that do not have this protein are Rh negative. This is what remains a mystery between Adam and Eve, we can know they had the same blood type but we do not know which blood type or if they were born with this protein or not. Never the less, this is important to understand because where blood typing plays a huge role is through conception. During pregnancy the Rh factor and blood typing is extremely important because the Rh negative and the Rh positive proteins are incompatible. If the mother and developing fetus are Rh incompatible, the mother's blood will start making antibodies against the Rh factor blood of her child. It is important to note that the first pregnancy is not affected by this incompatibility, it is the pregnancies after that are at high risk of the mother's blood rejecting the blood of her baby and this leads to infertility and miscarriages. Incompatibility is life threatening for both baby and mother.

The bible does not share with us how many miscarriages a mother had to go through to conceive a healthy baby to full term or if she had any miscarriages at all. The bible is silent on this issue, but science can shed some light on this subject through blood typing. While blood typing can become extremely complicated and is a medical field all unto itself, to keep this study simply and on track let's just keep all this information in mind and bring the bible back to the forefront of detail. Mankind was made in God's spiritual image and man and woman came from the same bloodline. The children through Adam and Eve would have been of the same bloodline of their parents, passing down the same genetics and spiritual natures onto their children and future children thereafter. Sadly, this didn't happen. Cain was of a different spiritual nature as his heart was murderous. This hidden detail helps us to understand that because the serpent was a spiritual being, the child he and Eve conceived together was a blood type separate from Adam and Eve's child; Abel.

A little something about blood types:

Science has hypothesized that the blood type AB is perhaps the oldest blood type. Subtle mutations genetically resulted in the AB blood type splitting and eventually formed the 'o' type blood groups. While this originally made sense, other scientists probed this further and discovered that perhaps the 'O' type blood group was the original blood grouping because it is more resistant to infectious disease, including malaria and some cancers, heart attacks and strokes to which other blood groups are susceptible to. This makes a strong case for the two

individuals who were created to be 'good' in every way their blood type may have been 'O' as they would have been able to withstand specific diseases and their children would inherit this blood type and Rh factor that would protect them and their children's children. This blood type would allow God's creation to live strong and healthy and recover quickly while resisting specific types of ailments that thrived outside of the protection of the garden of Eden.

While we will never know which blood type Adam and Eve were, we know that God put fail safes within our genetic code to off-set an unequal genetic balance. Science has circumvented the natural order of things as now a mother is given an injection on her second pregnancy to prevent blood type incompatibilities. This has created an instability within the incompatibility of human genetics to allow the enemy's character traits to become one with human nature. Because the life is in the blood, this lets us know that our spiritual essence, the very character that makes us who we are is hidden within our blood. The character that makes us similar to God's image and the character that makes us similar to the enemy's image is rooted in our blood. The righteous and unrighteous natures are locked up within our genetic code to which are passed down from parent to child throughout countless of generations. The symptoms are seen through genetic predispositions to specific mutations and birth defects, and diseases. Where science believe physical traits are passed down from parent to child through DNA coding, they also now believe that character traits are also passed down in the same way. Epigenetics is the discovery of specific genetic behaviors from parents can be switched on or off at a cellular level in the direct offspring or future generations of offspring.

So what does all this have to do with narcissism? The narcissist suffers from a personality disorder; or a dysfunction in their character. It isn't just one trait that is flawed, but a multitude of traits within their character that are problematic. God's character is love, the enemy's character is hate. Within the character of God's love exists the compulsion to think of others before oneself. To nurture, to be sympathetic and empathetic. Within the heart of the narcissist, there exists these things, but only on a superficial level. They can mimic these qualities but these qualities do not make the narcissist who they are in character. These qualities are missing on a deeper level and therefore these qualities cannot define a narcissist. What defines the narcissist is the opposite of nurturing and empathy, and love. The narcissist's true character is hate and within that hate, are opposing natures of God's love. Abandonment, emptiness, contempt is what the narcissist lives for. The narcissist hates period. The spiritual nature within is hate and tries to destroy anything that is opposite to this hate. This is why empathetic people are a narcissist's target. God's law states 'Love others as you love yourself.' The enemy's law is opposite to that; 'Hate others as you hate yourself.' A narcissist hates others as a narcissist hates himself because contrary to what was once popular belief, a narcissist is not a person who has an exaggerated high opinion of themselves and is in love with themselves. A narcissist actually suffers from low self-esteem that stays low and keeps getting lower that is why the pattern of abuse intensifies in narcissistic relationships. The more frequent and intense the abuse, the lower the narcissist feels about themselves.

It's all about levelling. A narcissist feels so low that they have to bring others down to their level or lower in emotion so that they feel emotionally above their audience as this allows them to become self-validated.

A narcissist does not and cannot live in the character of God. They will however use the character of God to suit their own selfish desires. Narcissists can be found as wolves in sheep's clothing; pretending to be Christian, pretending to be a humanitarian, as many narcissists can be found in positions of power. This makes narcissism difficult to diagnose let alone treat because narcissism gets powerful people more power by subjugating others in the name of greed.

Clinicians have determined that there are two major types of narcissism, and subtypes co-existing underneath these two types. However, keeping God in the details we can determine that the two types of people who become narcissistic; those who are born narcissists (Type A narcissist), and those who are influenced by narcissism and adopt narcissistic traits (Type B narcissist).

Type A: The Alpha male narcissist.

The Alpha male narcissists are directly predisposed to narcissism through genetics. The example given to us in scripture are the Nephilim. The offspring of the fallen angels. The serpent in the garden of Eden, he is the leader of the fallen angels and created a child with Eve; Cain. Alpha male narcissists in scripture are the 'true bloods' of the enemy as their father is the devil, the enemy and will forever be under the curse. These narcissists carry the curse of the garden in spirit as they unknowingly set out to destroy God's people; those who are empathetic and have a kind and caring disposition.

Biblical characters of the Alpha male narcissist: Cain, Nimrod, Goliath, Egyptian Pharaohs (Those who had elongated skulls) Canaanite clans, Edom (Esau, King Herod) Jezebel, Nebuchadnezzar, the Pharisees and Sadducees.

Type B: The Beta male narcissist:

The Beta male narcissists are individuals who by nature are not predisposed to narcissism through genetic design. Instead they are influenced by narcissistic people at an early age. The Beta narcissist is exposed to narcissism at important life developmental stages as they are imprinted with narcissistic behavior. They suffer narcissistic abuse at an early age and develop behavioral patterns based on this negative influence.

The Beta narcissist sits on the cusp of decision; to become a full-fledged narcissist in heart or to let go of his narcissistic tendencies and make a choice to live free and clear of it. The easiest way to overcome narcissism is through genuinely seeking the love of Jesus.

The Beta male narcissistic types within the bible are seen in the 12 tribes of Israel. The tribes of Benjamin and Dan are stark examples. King Saul was from the tribe of Benjamin. But even in the tribe of Judah we are shown narcissistic examples through King David and his family; his brother and his sons. Their actions always turned them away from the love of God but when they turned to sorrowful repentance, and kept themselves from sinful ways; God heard their cries and turned to them. With this type of narcissism, it is influential always, but it can be overcome!

PERSONAL INSIGHT FROM THE AUTHOR:

I was a foster child. I was placed in many foster homes that were negative. The most negative influence I had though was living with my birth mother who had issues with alcoholism and narcissism combined. I believe I was an unwanted child and this was made known to me through neglect of a mother to their child. This narcissistic environment was all I knew and it was what shaped my future as I adopted narcissistic tendencies. I somehow knew my behavior was wrong, but it felt like a knee jerk response. It was hard to change. I knew I had to change, not just for me but for those around me. I knew I couldn't continue to hurt the people I loved. My narcissistic tendencies hurt my children, my spouse, other family members and my friends. Narcissism even prevented me from gaining a closer walk with God. When I read for myself that God abhors anger, this challenged me to do better by becoming better. I began to look into scripture on ways to change me. Change was slow, but reading Galatians 5 and adopting its lessons really helped me to see the wrongs I was committing. I honestly did not know how to change any other way and when scripture began to expose the hidden love I had for Jesus that I never knew was there; I learned to forgive myself as I knew through repentance I was forgiven by our Father.

I am thankful that God in Heaven is our judge. Jesus brings us to our Father and chances are given to everyone. This is seen through the story of Cain and Abel. Cain had an adopted dad; Adam but did not carry Adam's character and even still God was willing to help and nurture this young man, but Cain could not see the value and beauty of God's love.

conclusion

The biblical understanding of narcissism can help us to address the growing issue of problem behavior among society today. As Christians we are obligated to see the world as how God created it, not as how the world was us to perceive it. The world is becoming an extremely dangerous place to live in and with narcissism becoming an epidemic,

the better we can understand the world through Godly perspectives, the safer and easier it is to live in today's challenging times.

It is important to live for Jesus, and it is equally important to heal our inner selves of narcissistic abuse because contrary to popular belief, narcissism is not a medical disorder that can be treated with in or out patient care. Yes, narcissism can be managed, but effectively there is no known medical cure outside of God's good and tender care. The reason is because narcissism is rooted in hate as it is a behavioral pattern by the enemy. The enemy hated Eve from the beginning, and narcissism in men are shown to hate women and treat woman as subordinate. While some people may disagree with the assessment that narcissism has everything to do with the enemy, more and more clinicians are beginning to speak out that the more severe the narcissism, they are seeing traits of possible possession. This does not mean that every narcissist is possessed. Oppressed certainly, and those of you who have experienced narcissism understand that the eyes are the window to the soul as the eyes reveal the hate and toxic nature of the spirit of the narcissist. Many people have witnessed a narcissist's eyes change, where the entire eye goes black. But not only that, the entire facial expressions change unnaturally to something sinister and unhuman like in the mouth and gaze is humanly disproportionate. It is an intimidating thing to witness as the narcissist stares at you with malevolent or evil intent. It is something that we should not be scare or intimidated by. When we have not healed ourselves inwardly and then we witness such extremes, the narcissist has us fearing for our lives. Fearing them over fearing our God.

The bible left us valuable clues on what types of behaviors to watch out for and psychiatry has allowed us to tap into self-help and healing measures by giving us insight into the symptoms of victimization. In the next episode I will share with you some healing strategies from narcissistic abuse as I have implemented these strategies to illicit God's help and tap into His insight about myself.
